The Griffith Observatory closed in 2002 for renovation and a major expansion of exhibit space. It reopened to the public on November 3, 2006, retaining its art deco exterior.

Directional signage, main entrance lighting and observation deck fixtures, were removed, cleaned, and rewired to function at maximum efficiency. Bronze elements throughout the building, including all wall moldings, ornaments, lighting fixtures, and vent grilles, were

removed, cleaned, rewired and given wax finishes before being reinstalled.
